The Morris Park Facility contains the Morris Park Locomotive... c1229c1407 The facility opened on November 1, 1889. Though used for train storage for over a century, it is mainly used for maintaining and refueling diesel locomotives and electro-diesel locomotives since the 1990s. The locomotive roundhouse was renovated in 2018, with construction being completed in late 2020. c1229c1407 == History == c1229c1407 == Description == c1229c1407 President Lázaro Cárdenas named the avenue after Tomáš Garrigue Masaryk, the first President of Czechoslovakia, in 1936. c1229c1407 In light of the farming, gardening, small fruit raising, and cultivation of root crops, the Franklinville freight depot was established by 1872. The building was renovated in the summer of 1879 to afford better accommodations for eventual passenger service. It was reported in 1887 that the total number of barrels of cauliflower carted from the depot was 3,762. More regular passenger service appears on timetables in April 1891, then disappears only to reappear in September 1892. The service again disappears but reappears in June 1894. It is listed as Franklinville as late as Employee Timetable #3 from June 1897, when the superintendent... c1229c1407 When British Rail could no longer justify the maintenance of the Louth line, Grimsby Borough Council agreed to research the route as a major traffic artery into and through the town centre. Engineering Consultants were appointed and quickly confirmed the route would have strategic significance for the town and provide a link from the south... c1229c1407 Safer Roads Humber had been accused of using Peaks Parkway as a cash cow for funding, using SPECS average speed cameras as a revenue generator. For example, pedestrians are prohibited from using Peaks Parkway. c1229c1407 The former bus station was called Freshney bus station and was situated outside the Freshney Place shopping centre. In 2013, plans were submitted to redevelop the bus station site by moving the bus stops. A nearby building was leased and a new cafe with toilets and bus departure information was built. The new bus station, dubbed "Riverhead Exchange", was opened in July 2014. The site of the former bus station was expected to become a cinema in an expansion of Freshney Place, but as of 2019, the site remains undeveloped. The cafe was closed in 2019 as the council decided not to renew its lease, reportedly due to financial restraints and low usage. c1229c1407 Yaphank station was originally built as Milleville station in 1845, and was spelled both as Millville or Milleville on LIRR timetables. It was renamed Yaphank a year later, and has kept that name ever since. The station also included a hotel until December 1873. Yaphank station was replaced by a second station building in 1875 that contained elaborate gingerbread woodwork. Before World War II, Yaphank station was known as the stop for the "Camp Siegfried Special," a train that took members of the German American Bund Nazi organization from parts of New York City to an infamous Hitler Youth camp known as Camp Siegfried. The decorative features were reduced considerably in June 1941, and then the station house was closed in 1958 and burned down in 1961.... c1229c1407 There are now

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proposals to build a new bus station in Grimsby. c1229c1407 Following on from public pressure, during 2014 North East Lincolnshire Council agreed to increase the speed limit on Peaks Parkway to 40 mph from the 30 mph previously in force, despite Safer Roads Humber advising the council to keep the 30 mph in force. c1229c1407 Waldbaum's operated full-service traditional supermarkets with varying footprints and store models and its popular marquee in certain aisles along with good food and reliable service. When the first G5s rolled out of the Juniata Shops in 1923, the Pennsylvania Railroad had not built a 4-6-0 in more than two decades. Mechanical Engineer William F. Kiesel Jr., who designed the engine, used the boiler from an E6s Atlantic and designed one of the largest and most powerful ten-wheelers ever built. Smaller drive wheels than an Atlantic and the lack of a trailing truck put more weight on the drivers and produced an engine with great power and acceleration but a lower top speed. The 4-6-0 wheel arrangement could provide sufficient tractive effort, (41,000 lbf (180 kN) of force) while at the same time allowing the locomotive to accelerate the train more quickly. Such a design was ideal for the frequent stops on PRR commuter lines. c1229c1407

Pennsylvania Railroad class G5 the frequent stops on PRR commuter lines. It was designed for passenger trains, particularly on commuter lines, and became a fixture on suburban railroads (notably the Long Island Rail Road) until the mid-1950s. 90 G5s locomotives were built for the PRR between 1923 and 1925 at the railroad's Juniata Shops in Altoona, Pennsylvania The Pennsylvania Railroad G5s is a class of 4-6-0 steam locomotives built by the PRR's Juniata Shops in the mid-late 1920s c1229c1407

The first depot was built in the hamlet of Franklinville. The area was renamed after securing a post office in February 1898. The name had to be changed as there already was a Franklinville in Cattaraugus County, NY. The residents voted to choose the name "Laurel" after the local lake. The station is first mentioned in the Gazetteer of the State of New York in 1872, so it was likely constructed around that time. c1229c1407 The Morris Park Facility covers about 21 acres (8.5 ha), and contains a locomotive shed and sidings for diesel locomotives and dual-mode electro-diesel locomotives. Originally it included a 23-stall brick locomotive roundhouse, an electric turntable, maintenance offices, and locomotive watering facilities. A smaller roundhouse and turntable, as well as a separate four-track shed, now exist on the site. The facility also includes storage and receiving yards; maintenance shops; and a train-car wash. c1229c1407 In 1999 the city of Prague donated a statue of Masaryk to Mexico City, one of the two originals made when the statue for the Prague Castle was being prepared for the 150th anniversary of his birth.
