HMS *Salvia* (K97) The corvette sank with all hands, and all of the survivors that she had rescued from *Shuntien* were also lost. torpedoes hit *Salvia*, breaking her in two and spilling her heavy black bunker oil onto the surface of the sea. She rescued many survivors from the prison ship *SS Shuntien* when it was sunk on 23 December 1941. The fuel caught fire and her stern section HMS *Salvia* (K97) was a Flower-class corvette of the Royal Navy. A few hours later, on Christmas Eve 1941, *Salvia* too was torpedoed. She was ordered on the eve of the Second World War and entered service in September 1940 61b9333fcf

In horticulture, *Salvia reptans* reaches 3 feet wide or more with abundant thin, black stems. The stems can make a groundcover. The narrow mistletoe-green leaves are sparse.
