The Falcons were the... 6cabdb1841 On December 13, 2017, Tommy Nobis, the first player drafted by the Falcons, died at the age of 74. 6cabdb1841 After a loss at home to the rival New Orleans Saints, the Falcons suffered their second consecutive losing season and were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the second year in a row. However, the Falcons went 6–2 over the final half of the season, tied for the best record in the NFC during that span, to finish the season with a 7–9 record for the second straight year and 2nd in the NFC South. 6cabdb1841 Following their Week 12 win over the Jacksonville Jaguars, the Falcons improved their 4–12 season from the previous year. The Falcons matched their 7–10 record from the previous season, but failed to qualify for the playoffs for the fifth consecutive season. Despite the setbacks, the Falcons defeated quarterback Tom Brady for the first time ever in his career during the last game of the regular season, avenging their Super Bowl LI loss. Also notable for the first time since 2007, long-time quarterback Matt Ryan was not on the roster as the Falcons traded him to Indianapolis on March 21. The team signed former Tennessee Titans and Las Vegas Raiders quarterback Marcus Mariota as their new quarterback on the same day. Mariota was reunited with Falcons head coach Arthur Smith, who served as the tight ends coach and offensive coordinator during Mariota's tenure with Tennessee (2015–2019). As of the 2024 season, this season is the Falcons' most recent last-place finish in the NFC South. 6cabdb1841 It was also their final season with quarterback Matt Ryan, who had been with the team since 2008, as he was traded to the Indianapolis Colts for the following season. The Falcons also got rid of Calvin Ridley after the season. 6cabdb1841 In 1952, businessman Max Hoffman became the sole importer of Mercedes-Benz cars to the United States. However, with the relative success the brand's cars enjoyed in the 1950s, Daimler was no longer content with selling through a middleman, and sought to start its own American operation. It thus entered a partnership with the struggling Studebaker-Packard Corporation in 1957. Though Mercedes sales shot up from just 36 in 1953 to around 12,000 by 1959, it did not satisfy Daimler, and was also hindered by Studebaker's woes, with the US factory in South Bend, Indiana ending in 1963 and production continuing in Canada only through 1966, as dealers dwindled and service quality suffered, thus Daimler executive Heinz Hoppe bought out the 14-year contract for approximately \$5 million, plus distribution assets. With Studebaker faltering, trying to retain viable outlets, Daimler recruited about 200 top-performing Studebaker dealership owners, sending them to West Germany for brand training. With that, it was able to found its own independent... 6cabdb1841 For the first time since 2010, wide receiver Julio Jones was not on the roster as he was traded to the Tennessee Titans on June 6, 2021. Jones departed Atlanta holding the most career receiving yards and receptions in Falcons franchise history. 6cabdb1841 The roots of the brand trace back to the 1901 Mercedes by Daimler-Motoren-Gesellschaft and the 1886 Benz Patent-Motorwagen and 1894 Benz Velo by Carl Benz, which is widely recognised as the first automobile powered by an internal combustion engine. The brand's slogan is "The Best or Nothing". 6cabdb1841 This was the Falcons' first year in Mercedes-Benz Stadium after spending the previous 25 seasons in the Georgia Dome, which was demolished on November 20, 2017. Mercedes-Benz Stadium opened as scheduled on August 26, 2017; however, its retractable roof system was incomplete. The roof of Mercedes-Benz Stadium remained in the closed position for most of the 2017 season,

With a 34–20 loss to the Green Bay Packers, the Falcons fell to 4–9 and suffered their first losing season since the 2014 season. Despite beating the Arizona Cardinals 40–14 in Week 15, the Falcons were eliminated from playoff contention for the first time since 2015 with a win by the Minnesota Vikings.
