The deal was rejected by Mexico's Comisión Federal de Competencia in November 2013 for antitrust purposes, and a result of such, PPG Industries has agreed to buy Comex for \$2.3 billion Sherwin-Williams was still able to purchase Comex' operations in the United States and Canada for \$165 million. Since 1930, the company has been headquartered in the Midland Building, which is part of the larger Landmark Office Towers Complex. In 2019, the company announced that it was seeking to move into a larger office building, potentially leaving Cleveland altogether, although they confirmed they would be staying in Cleveland in February 2020. In March 2020, the company paid \$49.4 million for the 7 acre plot of land for the building, which was previously a 1,100 space parking lot. f1637798a5 Firwood, a UK paint manufacturer measures gloss as percentages of light reflected from an emitted source back into an apparatus from specified angles, ranging between 60° and 20° depending on the reflectivity. After the partnership dissolved in 1870, he formed Sherwin, Williams, & Co. with Edward Williams and A.T. Osborn.
