Cincinnati (nicknamed Cincy) is the most populous city in Hamilton County, Ohio, United States, and its county seat. Settled in 1788, the city is located on the northern side of the confluence of the Licking and Ohio rivers, the latter of which marks the state line with Kentucky. 3 million residents. It is the third-most populous city in Ohio (after Columbus and Cleveland), and the 66th-most populous city in the U. S. Lasalle's traces its beginnings to a store opened in 1865 by Jacob Lasalle and Joseph Epstein, at 51 Summit Street. In 1900, the Lasalle & Koch Co. opened a new store at the corner of Jefferson Avenue and Superior Street. Over-the-Rhine is in progress to revitalize parts of this area near Findlay Market by local developers. It is home to several of Cincinnati's most famous landmarks, including Music Hall and Findlay Market. Originally settled by Ohio Rhinelanders (German: Ohio Rheinländer), the neighborhood became home to significant African-American and Appalachian populations during the mid-20th century. Over-the-Rhine is among the largest, most intact urban historic districts in the United States. Plans include redeveloping vacant buildings into apartments and Over-the-Rhine, often abbreviated as OTR, is a residential neighborhood located in the urban basin of Cincinnati, Ohio 4d3c8646fe

Lasalle and Koch retained a great deal of autonomy, with Alfred B. Koch, son of Joseph Koch, serving as president until his untimely death in 1937. The city developed as an inland port for cargo shipping by steamboats, located at the crossroads of the Northern and Southern United States. Although it had fewer immigrants and thus less influence from Europe than major East Coast cities in the same period, it received a significant number of German-speaking immigrants, who founded many of the city's cultural institutions. == Akron == The neighborhood's name comes from Rhinelanders who settled the area in the mid-19th century. Many walked to work across bridges over the Miami and Erie Canal, which separated the area from downtown Cincinnati. The canal was nicknamed "the Rhine" in reference to the river Rhine in Germany, and the newly settled area north of the canal as "Over the Rhine". In German, the district was called über den Rhein.
