

What Time Does The Indy 500 Start

The two to three weeks of practice and qualifying leading up to the Indianapolis 500 is known in racing circles simply as "the month of May [at Indianapolis]". In early years, the track traditionally opened for practice on May 1 (regardless of the day of the week). This practice dated back to 1911. The month of May began with Rookie Orientations on May 7, and the track was opened to all competitors for practice two days later. Time trials were scheduled to be held on May 13-14 and May 20-21; however, the first two days were rained out, forcing IRL officials to push pole qualifying back to May 20. Sam Hornish Jr. of Team Penske quickly emerged as a pre-race favorite, setting quickest times in all but one practice session and earning the pole position. The last day of qualifying, Bump Day, saw a battle for the final starting position between Thiago Medeiros and Marty Roth. Medeiros took the position after Roth crashed with less than an hour left. The 30th annual Pit Stop Challenge was won by Hélio Castroneves' pit crew. Five-time IndyCar Series champion, and 2008 race winner Scott Dixon started in the middle of the front row, and dominated much of the race. Dixon led 111 laps, and led by as many as 7 seconds at one point during the first half. After the final round of pit stops, however, Takuma Sato chased down and passed Dixon for position on lap 172, which proved to be the winning move. After all other cars had cycled through their final pit stops, Sato elevated to the lead on lap 186. He was leading the race... A. J. Foyt is the most successful driver, with four wins. Rick Mears won the race three times during the CART years, and Will Power has won three times under IndyCar sanctioning. On April 21, 2021, the track management announced that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the event would be held with a limit of 135,000 spectators, approximately 40% capacity. The previous year's race was postponed from May 24 to August 23, then ultimately held without spectators, as was the GMR Grand Prix (which was moved to July 4). The Intercontinental GT Challenge meeting in October 2020, which included the twin road course races for INDYCAR, carried a 10,000 spectator limit, with spectators restricted to grandstands in what are normally Turn 4 and Turn 1 on the oval (Turns 1-4 and Turns 12-14 on the road course).
