The government revenue from fuel duty was £27.1 billion for the financial year 2014-2015. This is an increase in cash terms in comparison to 2013-2014 but now only represents 1.5% of GDP. This is in contrast to the start of the 2000s when it was 2.3% of GDP. A further £3.9 billion is raised from the VAT on the duty, contributing some 3.5 per cent of total UK tax revenues. Fuel protests in the United Kingdom There have been three major campaigns amongst many other protests in the 21st century. The fuel protests in the United Kingdom were a series of campaigns held in response to the

rising petrol and diesel fuel prices for road vehicle use. The aim of the protests was to secure a reduction in the fuel duty rate on petrol and diesel, which the government refused to enact. Protests and blockades of oil facilities caused widespread disruption to the supply of petroleum products. The first major protest in 2000 was primarily led by independent lorry owner-operators. After the protest ended, the government did announce a freeze on fuel duties, and promised changes would be made to the way that goods vehicles were taxed, which would include the taxing of foreign vehicles operating on British roads. One group of lorry owner-operators from the South East of England formed a protest group called "TransAction" that protested at oil refineries and fuel depots in Essex.
