After the company sold the American Bank Note Company Building in 1988, the structure was sold to numerous owners, and renovated into offices and residences. The American Bank Note Company Building is a New York City designated landmark and listed on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). It is also a contributing property to the Wall Street Historic District, a NRHP... Before the invention of washing machines and indoor plumbing, clothes had to be washed by hand in a multi-step process that often occupied an entire day of work, plus drying and ironing. The first English patent under the category of washing machines was issued in 1691. Brooklyn Tower Also included within the kitchens are black and bronze cabinetry with countertops made of The Brooklyn Tower (formerly 340 Flatbush Avenue Extension and 9 DeKalb Avenue; also 55 Fleet Street and 85 Fleet Street) is a supertall mixed-use, primarily residential skyscraper in the Downtown Brooklyn neighborhood of New York City. including refrigerators, dishwashers, ovens, and washer-dryers. Developed by JDS Development Group, it is situated on the north side of DeKalb Avenue near Flatbush Avenue. Preserved at the skyscraper's base is the Dime Savings Bank Building, designed by Mowbray and Uffinger, which dates to the 1900s and is a New York City designated landmark. It was built by Robert Wilson Patterson, editor of the Chicago Tribune newspaper, and used by him and his family for entertaining when he was in the city. Completed in 1903, it was deeded to the American Red Cross in 1948. The Red Cross sold it to the Washington Club in 1951. The structure was renovated and given a two-story addition in 1955.
