Diagnosis of hair loss is partly based on the areas... == History == Common types include male- or female-pattern hair loss, alopecia areata, and a thinning of hair known as telogen effluvium. The cause of male-pattern hair loss is a combination of genetics and male hormones; the cause of female pattern hair loss is unclear; the cause of alopecia areata is autoimmune; and the cause of telogen effluvium is typically a physically or psychologically stressful event. Telogen effluvium is very common following pregnancy.

More formally, ulotrichous ('curly-haired' from Ancient Greek: οὔλος, romanized: oûlos, lit. 'crisp, curly' and Ancient Greek: θρίξ, romanized: thrîx, lit. 'hair') refers to afro-textured hair, its antonym being leiotrichous ('smooth-haired'). Jean Baptiste Bory de Saint-Vincent in 1825 introduced the scientific term Oulotrichi for the purpose of human taxonomy. 803cc8d701

But the first major departure from the tradition of clean-shaven chief executives was Abraham Lincoln (1861–1865), who was supposedly (and famously) influenced by a letter received from an eleven-year-old girl named Grace Bedell, to start growing a beard to improve his chances of being elected. After Lincoln, all but two presidents over the next 48 years sported some form of facial hair; the exceptions being Andrew Johnson (1865–1869) and William McKinley (1897–1901). 803cc8d701

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
