In other prominent matches, The Shield (Dean Ambrose, Roman Reigns, and Seth Rollins) defeated Ryback and WWE Tag Team Champions Team Hell No (Kane and Daniel Bryan) in a six-man tag team Tables, Ladders, and Chairs match, which was also The Shield's debut match as a stable, and Big Show defeated Sheamus in a Chairs match to retain the World Heavyweight Championship. f532469b93 The event was

established during the first WWE brand extension, and the inaugural event featured wrestlers from the Raw, SmackDown, and ECW brands. Following ECW's disbandment in 2010, the 2010 TLC event only featured Raw and SmackDown before the first brand extension ended in August 2011. The brand split was reinstated in 2016, and TLC that year was exclusively a SmackDown-branded event. In 2017, it was held exclusively for Raw. The main event saw Bray Wyatt defeat Dean Ambrose in a Tables, Ladders, and Chairs match. Nine matches were contested at the event, including one on the Kickoff pre-show. In the main event, WWE Champion Randy Orton defeated World Heavyweight Champion John Cena in a Winner Takes All Tables, Ladders, and Chairs match to unify the titles as the WWE World Heavyweight Championship. The unified title continued the lineage of the WWE Championship while the World Heavyweight Championship was immediately retired with Orton recognized as its final holder. In other prominent matches, Cody Rhodes and Goldust retained the WWE Tag Team Championship in a fatal four-way tag team elimination match against Big Show and Rey Mysterio, The Real Americans (Jack Swagger and Antonio Cesaro), and RybAxel (Ryback and Curtis Axel), The Wyatt Family (Bray Wyatt, Luke Harper, and Erick Rowan) defeated Daniel Bryan in a 3-on-1 handicap... f532469b93

It was the last TLC held under the first brand split, which ended in August 2011, but was reinstated in July 2016. The concept of the show was based
