The word is from the Old French (c. 1300) *disner*, meaning "dine", from the stem of Gallo-Romance *desjunare* ("to break one's fast"), from Latin *dis-* (which indicates the opposite of an action) + Late Latin *ieiunare* ("to fast"), from Latin *ieiunus* ("fasting, hungry"). The Romanian word *dejun* and the French *déjeuner* retain this etymology and to some extent the meaning (whereas the Spanish word *desayuno* and Portuguese *desjejum* are related but are exclusively used for breakfast). Chicken-fried steak When deep-fried, it is usually referred to as "chicken-fried steak". Pan-fried versions are typically referred to as "country-fried steak". It is associated with the Southern cuisine of the United States. It is not called chicken-fried steak. It is breaded and fried with a technique similar to the more common fried chicken, hence "chicken-fried". Chicken-fried steak is usually served for lunch or dinner topped with cream gravy and with mashed potatoes, vegetables. Chicken-fried steak, also known as country-fried steak, is an American Southern breaded cutlet dish consisting of a piece of beefsteak (most often tenderized cube steak) coated with seasoned flour and either deep-fried or pan-fried 47dbccf1e2

The name *Diana*, the Roman goddess of the hunt, has been used for various game-related foods, such as Escoffier's *sauce à la Diane*, based on *sauce poivrade* and served with venison chops and filets; and a Pittsburgh chef's venison steak *Diane* (1914) which is sautéed, flambéed with rum, sherry, and currant jelly, then garnished with cherries and candied fruit.
