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hall, in what was Lincoln's office suite). Domestic staff used it for storage, kitchens, and maintenance. White House domestic staff gathered in this room to do mending and polish silver. In 1837, the Van Buren administration installed a furnace here for the White House's first central heating system. Later steam boilers replaced the gravity system, remaining until the 1902 renovation by McKim, Mead, and White. 8bfaada63b

East Room The East Room is the largest room in the Executive Residence; it is used for dances, receptions, press conferences, ceremonies, concerts, and banquets. light blue curtains, and imported French silver wallpaper with a gold border were added to the East Room by the Martin Van Buren administration in 1839 The East Room is an event and reception room in the Executive Residence of the White House complex, the home of the president of the United States. Since 1964, the Committee for the Preservation of the White House has, by executive order, advised the president of the United States and first lady on the decor, preservation, and conservation of the East Room and other public rooms at the White House. The East Room was one of the last rooms to be finished and decorated, and it has undergone substantial redecoration over the past two centuries 8bfaada63b

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From 1997 to 2022, prime ministers Tony Blair, Gordon Brown, David Cameron, Theresa May and Boris Johnson chose to reside for all or part of their term of office in the flat above Number 11, as its residential apartment is larger than at Number 10. Rishi Sunak broke with this by resuming residence in the smaller flat above Number 10. Keir Starmer, his wife Victoria, and their two children lived above Number 11.

Rose Cumming In Cumming's own town house, the living room had early-eighteenth-century hand-painted Chinese wallpaper with a silvery background and Louis XV Rose Cumming (1887 – March 21, 1968) was a flamboyant and eccentric interior decorator whose career was based in New York.

The room is the point of entry to the White House for a visiting head of state following the State Arrival Ceremony on the South Lawn. The Zuber wallpaper, titled The Diplomatic Reception Room is one of three oval rooms in the Executive Residence of the White House, the official home of the president of the United States. It is located on the ground floor and is used as an entrance from the South Lawn and a reception room for foreign ambassadors to present their credentials, a ceremony formerly conducted in the Blue Room 8bfaada63b
