Rhodes piano Like a conventional piano, the Rhodes generates sound with keys and hammers, but instead of strings, the hammers strike thin metal tines, which vibrate next to an electromagnetic pickup. The 73-key model weighs around 130 The Rhodes piano (also known as the Fender Rhodes piano) is an electric piano invented by Harold Rhodes, which became popular in the 1970s. The signal is sent through a cable to an external keyboard amplifier and speaker. Development continued after the war and into the following decade. In 1959, Fender began marketing the Piano Bass, a cut-down version; the full-size instrument did not appear until after Fender's sale to CBS in 1965. CBS oversaw mass production of the Rhodes piano in the 1970s, and it was used extensively through the decade, particularly in jazz, pop, and soul music, as well by many rock artists. It was less used in the 1980s because of competition with polyphonic and digital synthesizers such as the Yamaha DX7 and inconsistent quality control caused by cost-cutting. fb1581c6d4

Piano history and musical performance [1] The hammers The modern form of the piano, which emerged in the late 19th century, is a very different instrument from the pianos for which earlier classical piano literature was originally composed. The contrast with earlier instruments, particularly those of the 18th century (with light wooden frames, lightly sprung actions, and short sustain time) is very noticeable. These changes have given rise to interpretive questions and controversies about performing earlier literature on modern pianos, particularly since recent decades have seen the revival of historical instruments for concert use. These changes have created a piano with a powerful tone that carries well in large halls, and which produces notes with a very long sustain time. robustness. The modern piano has a heavy metal frame, thick strings made of top-grade steel, and a sturdy action with a substantial touch weight. A modern Steinway Model D weighs 480 kg (1,060 lb)[citation needed], about six times the weight of a late 18th-century Stein piano fb1581c6d4

ROLI Seaboard It has a continuous sensor-embedded flexible rubber surface for playing the keys instead of traditional lever-style "moving keys". It has what the manufacturer calls "5D technology" which consists of five types of responsiveness to player actions: "strike", "glide" and "press", front to rear movement "slide" sensitivity, and release-velocity "lift" (RISE keyboard only). The Seaboard also features polyphonic aftertouch, and a built-in USB- charged battery. These responsiveness tools can be used to play the Seaboard with microtonal pitch bend sounds (like a fretless bass guitar), by moving the finger from note to note, or trigger a vibrato effect into a string patch just by wiggling the finger, which would not be possible on a traditional MIDI controller using only the keys. Some models, like the RISE Seaboard Grand, have an onboard sound engine. how hard you The Seaboard is a musical keyboard-style MIDI controller manufactured by the British music technology company ROLI. whereas with a normal piano, you just have to play the correct notes at the correct volume; with the Seaboard, you also have to focus on ". There are three Seaboard models: the small minikkey BLOCK (24 keys), the RISE (25- or 49-key versions), and the GRAND, an 88-key keyboard with an onboard sound engine fb1581c6d4

In addition, they do not need to be tuned, and their tuning A digital piano is a class of electronic keyboard or synthesizer (rompler) designed to serve primarily as an alternative to the traditional acoustic piano, both in how it feels to play and in the sound it produces. Digital pianos use either synthesized emulation or recorded samples of an acoustic piano, which are played through one or more internal loudspeakers. Others may be very simple, without a stand. They also incorporate weighted keys, which recreate the feel of an acoustic piano fb1581c6d4

ROLI calls the five responsiveness triggers "5D technology".... fb1581c6d4 While digital pianos may sometimes fall short of acoustic ones in feel and sound, their advantages include being smaller, weighing much less, and costing less than an acoustic piano. In addition, they do not need to be tuned, and their tuning can be modified to match the tuning of another instrument (e.g. a pipe organ). Like other electronic musical instruments, they can be connected to an amplifier or a PA system to produce a sound loud enough for a large venue or, at the other extreme, may be heard through headphones only. Some digital pianos can emulate other sounds besides the piano, the most common ones being pipe organ... fb1581c6d4 Vinnie Colaiuta - drums fb1581c6d4 In the early 21st century, the obvious way to raise the technological level of any mechanical device is to use digital technology to control it (compare the mid 19th century, where the obvious route was to make some of its parts from steel; e.g. piano strings). Of course, digital technology has been incorporated into pianos, and this innovation is discussed below. But in a sense, it is a far greater challenge to improve the piano in its own terms, as a mechanical/acoustic device. This challenge pits the modern piano designer against some of the finest engineering minds of the nineteenth century, an era when pianos represented some of the most sophisticated of all technological achievements.
