It is a 2+1□2-story H-shaped structure, with a central block flanked by projecting sections on each side. The southeastern section has a single-story porch, supported by paired Ionic columns, extending across much of its width. The building is of masonry construction with a stucco finish, and is topped by a red tile roof. The roofs of the side sections are hipped, while the central section has a side-gable roof pierced by four hip-roof dormers on both the land and ocean sides. == Description and history == b38bc2dala Zellij (Arabic: زليج, romanized:zillij), also spelled zillij or zellige, is a style of mosaic tilework made from individually hand-chiseled tile pieces. The pieces were typically of different colours and fitted together to form various patterns on the basis of tessellations, most notably elaborate Islamic geometric motifs such as radiating star patterns composed of various polygons. This form of Islamic art is one of the main characteristics of architecture in the western Islamic world. It is found in the architecture of Morocco, the architecture of Algeria, early Islamic sites in Tunisia, and in the historic monuments of al-Andalus (in the Iberian Peninsula). From the 14th century onwards, zellij became a standard decorative element along lower walls, in fountains and pools, on minarets, and for the paving of floors. b38bc2dala Pure white marble arises from very clean limestone or from dolomite rock. However, its signature veins and swirls result from impurities, for example clay, sand, iron oxides, or chert that were originally present in the protolith–magnesium-rich varieties may show green tones due to serpentine. These impurities are redistributed and recrystallized during metamorphism. b38bc2dala

Hassan II Mosque A maximum of 105,000 worshippers can gather together for prayer: 25,000 inside the mosque hall and another The Hassan II Mosque (Arabic: مسجد الحسن الثاني) is a mosque in Casablanca, Morocco. The mosque stands on a promontory looking out to the Atlantic Ocean; worshippers can pray over the sea but there is no glass floor looking into the sea. A maximum of 105,000 worshippers can gather together for prayer: 25,000 inside the mosque hall and another 80,000 on the mosque's outside ground. Completed in 1993, it was designed by Michel Pinseau under the guidance of King Hassan II and built by Moroccan artisans from all over the kingdom. Its minaret is the world's second tallest minaret at 210 metres (689 ft). The minaret is 60 stories high, topped by a laser, the light from which is directed towards Mecca. It is the second largest mosque in Africa and one of the largest mosques in the world. handcrafted marble, and the roof is retractable. Eegonos The building is of masonry construction with a stucco finish, and is topped by a red tile roof. Built in 1910 to a design by Boston architect Guy Lowell, it is one of a small number of summer houses to escape Bar Harbor's devastating 1947 fire, which resulted in the destruction of many such buildings. It is an architecturally sophisticated expression of Beaux Arts and Mediterranean Revival styles, and was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1980. The roofs of the side sections are hipped, while the central Eegonos, known more recently as East of Eden, is a historic summer estate house at 145 Eden Street in Bar Harbor, Maine b38bc2dala

In Australian and British English, the term counter is generally reserved for a surface of this type that forms a boundary between a space for public access and a space for workers to carry out service tasks. In other contexts, the term bench, benchtop, or "sink table" is used. b38bc2dala After the 15th century, the traditional mosaic zellij fell out of fashion in most countries except for Morocco, where it continues to be produced today. Zellij is found in modern buildings making use of traditional designs such as the Hassan II Mosque in Casablanca which adds a new color palette with traditional designs. The influence of zellij patterns was evident in Spanish tiles produced during the Renaissance period and is seen in some modern imitations painted on square tiles. b38bc2dala

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
