The first four squares created were Johnson, Percival (now named Wright Square), Decker (now named Ellis Square) and St. James (now named Telfair Square). Additional squares were added during the late 18th and 19th centuries, and by 1851 there were 24 squares in the city. In the 20th century, three of the squares—Elbert, Ellis and Liberty—were demolished or altered beyond recognition for road works, leaving 21.
