Incandescent light bulb This has been accelerated by An incandescent light bulb, also known as an incandescent lamp or incandescent light globe, is an electric light that produces illumination by Joule heating a filament until it glows. 100 lm/W for typical white LED lamps. The filament is enclosed in a glass bulb that is either evacuated or filled with inert gas to protect the filament from oxidation. Lamps usually have a base made of ceramic, metal, glass, or plastic that secures them in the socket of a light fixture. incandescent lamps. The electrical connection to the socket may be made with a screw-thread base, two metal pins, two metal caps or a bayonet mount. It is the most common form of artificial lighting

In the United States, early manufacturers of incandescent lamps used several different and incompatible bases in the 1880s and 1890s. In designing his screw, Edison copied the lid... Compared to general-service incandescent lamps giving the same amount of visible light, CFLs use one-fourth to one-third the electric power, and last eight to fifteen times longer. A CFL has a higher purchase price than an incandescent lamp, but can save over five times its purchase price in electricity costs over the lamp's lifetime. Like all fluorescent lamps, CFLs contain toxic mercury, which complicates their disposal. In many countries, governments have banned the disposal of CFLs together with regular garbage. These countries have established special collection systems for CFLs and other hazardous waste.

Sockets allow lamps to be safely and conveniently replaced (re-lamping). Many of the later standards conform to a general coding system in which a socket type is designated by a letter or abbreviation followed by a number. Halogen lamp The small size of halogen lamps permits their use in compact optical systems for projectors and illumination. lamp. The small glass envelope may be enclosed in a much larger outer glass bulb, which has a lower temperature, protects the inner bulb from contamination, and makes the bulb mechanically more similar to a conventional lamp. Standard and halogen incandescent bulbs are much less efficient than LED and compact fluorescent lamps, and therefore have been or are being banned A halogen lamp (also called tungsten halogen, quartz-halogen, and quartz iodine lamp) is an incandescent lamp consisting of a tungsten filament sealed in a compact transparent envelope that is filled with a mixture of an inert gas and a small amount of a halogen, such as iodine or bromine. This allows the filament to operate at a higher temperature than a standard incandescent lamp of similar power and operating life; this also produces light with higher luminous efficacy and color temperature. The combination of the halogen gas and the tungsten filament produces a halogen-cycle chemical reaction, which redeposits evaporated tungsten on the filament, increasing its life and maintaining the clarity of the envelope a29b66366b

Fluorescent lamp fixtures are more costly than incandescent lamps because, among other things, they require a ballast to regulate current through the lamp, but the initial cost is offset by a much lower running cost. Compact fluorescent lamps (CFL) made in the same sizes as incandescent lamp bulbs are used as an energy-saving alternative to incandescent lamps in homes. a29b66366b

Mogul lamp This entire setting is typically covered, at least partially, by a large cylindrical (or bell-shaped) fabric shade which is fitted over the reflector bowl, an upturned, white-colored glass, hemispherical diffuser surrounding the center bulb. Fluorescent lamp Fluorescent lamps convert electrical energy into visible light much more efficiently than incandescent lamps, but are less efficient A fluorescent lamp, or fluorescent tube, is a low-pressure mercury-vapor gas-discharge lamp that uses fluorescence to produce visible light. Fluorescent lamps convert electrical energy into visible light much more efficiently than incandescent lamps, but are less efficient than most LED lamps. coating in the lamp glow. An electric current in the gas excites mercury vapor, to produce ultraviolet and make a phosphor coating in the lamp glow. The typical luminous efficacy of fluorescent lamps is 50–100 lumens per watt, several times the efficacy of general lighting incandescent bulbs with comparable light output, which is on the close order of 16 lm/W a29b66366b

== History == a29b66366b Incandescent bulbs are manufactured in a wide range of sizes, light output, and voltage ratings, from 1.5 volts to about 300 volts. They require no external regulating equipment, have low manufacturing costs, and work equally well on either alternating current or direct current. As a result, the incandescent bulb became widely used in household and commercial lighting, for portable lighting such as table lamps, car headlamps, and flashlights, and for decorative and advertising lighting. a29b66366b

The driver circuit may require special features to be compatible with lamp dimmers intended for use on incandescent lamps.
