Quavers were originally made by Smiths in their factory on Newark Road in the Bracebridge area of Lincoln in 1968. It launched with the advertising slogan "you get a lovely lot of Quavers in a bag", described as "curly potato puffs". The brand was originally sold in cheese and smoky bacon flavours, but over the years flavours like Spicy Beef, Sweet and Sour, Prawn Cocktail, and Ketchup were also part of the range. 93cbaee85a In March 1996, Walkers relaunched Quavers with a new look and advertising campaign produced by Aardman Animations, featuring new mascot Quentin Quaverhead and his family, who represent the "lightness" of the product. When Walkers purchased Wotsits, early plans were put in place in October 2002 to rebrand Wotsits under the Cheetos name (owned by their parent company PepsiCo). Walkers previously released the Cheetos brand in Britain, but with little success. However, nothing came to be of this planned change and Walkers kept the Wotsits brand as is with a new look, replacing Cheetos. Wotsits relaunched with a brand new look and advertising campaign on 3 January 2003, and the main cheese flavour was named Really Cheesy. 93cbaee85a In 1932, salesman Herman Lay opened a snack food operation in Nashville, Tennessee. The chips saw their debut at the 14th annual Alliston Potato Festival in 1987, gained quick popularity amongst festival attendees and completely

In 2010, Cheetos was ranked as the top selling brand of cheese puffs in its primary market of the U.S.; worldwide the annual retail sales totaled approximately \$4 billion. The original Crunchy Cheetos are still in production but the product line has since expanded to include 21 different types of Cheetos in North America alone.
