Flea Adult fleas grow to about 3 millimetres (1/8 inch) long, are usually dark in color, and have bodies that are "flattened" sideways or narrow, enabling them to move through their hosts' fur or feathers. Adult fleas grow to about 3 millimetres (1/8 inch) long Flea, the common name for the order Siphonaptera, includes 2,500 species of small flightless insects that live as external parasites of mammals and birds. Fleas live by ingesting the blood of their hosts. Some species can leap 50 times their body length, a feat second only to jumps made by another group of insects, the superfamily of froghoppers. as external parasites of mammals and birds. Their claws keep them from being dislodged, and their mouthparts are adapted for piercing skin and sucking blood. Fleas live by ingesting the blood of their hosts. Flea larvae are worm-like, with no limbs; they have chewing mouthparts and feed on organic debris left on their hosts' skin. They lack wings; their hind legs are extremely well adapted for jumping a8c16bcb35

== Description == a8c16bcb35 == Description == a8c16bcb35 Named in 1835 by Peter Friedrich Bouché, *A. erinacei* is a common flea "found on every hedgehog, usually in large numbers". A typical number of fleas on a hedgehog is about a hundred, but up to a thousand have been reported on sick animals. The flea is occasionally found also on dogs and cats, but only temporarily, and has been known to cause allergic dermatitis in dogs. It has also been found on foxes. The flea's length is between 2 and 3.5 millimetres, and its food is the blood of the host. a8c16bcb35

Natural reservoir A reservoir is usually a living host of a particular species, such as an animal, human, or plant, within which the pathogen survives, often without causing a8c16bcb35
