They may include itchiness, swelling of the tongue, vomiting, diarrhea, hives, trouble breathing, or low blood pressure. factory-scale peanut shelling/crushing environment, or from cooking, can induce respiratory effects in allergic individuals. When the symptoms are severe, it is known as anaphylaxis. This typically occurs within minutes to several hours of exposure. The symptoms of the allergic reaction may range from mild to severe. A food intolerance and food poisoning are separate conditions, not due to an immune response 81180600f7

Common foods involved include cow's milk, peanuts, eggs, shellfish, fish, tree nuts, soy, wheat, and sesame. The common allergies vary depending on the country. Risk factors include a family history of allergies, vitamin D deficiency, obesity, and high levels of cleanliness. Allergies occur when immunoglobulin E (IgE), part of the body's immune system, binds to molecules in food, usually proteins. This triggers the release of inflammatory chemicals such as histamine. Kuih In China, where the term originates, koé in Hokkien and kué in Teochew (known as guǒ in Mandarin) refer to snacks which are typically made from rice but can occasionally be made from other grains, such as wheat. Many Kuih (Jawi: كويه; Indonesian: kue; derived from Southern Min koé 𪔐) are bite-sized snack or dessert foods commonly found in Southeast Asia (particularly in the Malay Archipelago) and China. The term kuih is widely used in Malaysia, Brunei, and Singapore; kueh (the pre-1972 spelling of kuih) is used in Singapore and Indonesia; kue is used in Indonesia only; and all three refer to sweet or savoury desserts. It is a fairly broad term which may include items that would be called cakes, cookies, dumplings, pudding, biscuits, or pastries in English and are usually made from rice or glutinous rice. It is typically cooked on a griddle and topped with caster sugar, ground peanut, creamed corn, and grated coconut in the middle, and then turned over 81180600f7

Others trace it back to 1966, when the Palm Beach Post used it in a story: "Adults, when under severe emotional stress, turn to what could be called 'comfort food'—food associated with the security of childhood, like mother's poached egg or famous chicken soup." According to research by April White at JSTOR, it might have been Liza Minnelli who used the term for the first time in its modern meaning in an interview, admitting to craving a hamburger. 81180600f7 Fruits are the means by which angiosperms disseminate their seeds.
