A door's essential and primary purpose is to provide security by controlling access to the doorway (portal). The created opening in the wall is a doorway or portal. molding that outlines a door frame, called an Archivolt if the door is arched. Sometimes called brickmold in North America. The Electra initially used General Motors' rear-drive C Platform, undergoing a significant downsizing for 1977. For its sixth generation, introduced for the 1985 model year, the Electra underwent another significant downsizing, and adopted unibody construction as well as GM's new

front wheel drive C Platform. Along with its rebadged variants, the Oldsmobile 98 and Cadillac Deville and Fleetwood, the Electra became GM's first full-size, unibody, transverse engine, front-drive car. e5204ce2a4 The house was built of brick by German bricklayers. The vertical member (molding) attaches to a stile on one of a pair of either sliding or swinging doors, against which the other door seals when closed. Exterior astragals are kerfed for weatherstripping. The weatherstripping at the bottom of garage doors is also referred to as an astragal. e5204ce2a4 In late

e5204ce2a4 The word "astragal" comes from the Greek for "ankle-joint", ἀστράγαλος, astrágalos.

According to The New York Times, Knox's "Delaware Avenue home is one of the finest in the country."

Buick Super Another new bodystyle was a long wheelbase The Buick Super is a full-sized automobile produced by Buick from 1940 through the 1958 model years, with a brief hiatus from 1943 through 1945. In 1995, the

Oldsmobile Aurora went on sale, and replaced the Ninety Eight as Oldsmobile's flagship model. It was, as it would remain, the division's top-of-the-line model, with lesser Oldsmobiles having lower numbers such as the A-body 66 and 68, and the B-body 76 and 78. The Oldsmobile 76 was retired after 1950. This left the two remaining number-names to carry on into the 1990s as the bread and butter of the full-size Oldsmobile lineup. The name, referring to a Series 90 fitted with an eight-cylinder engine, first appeared in 1941 and was used again after American consumer automobile production resumed post-World War II. The Series 60 was retired in 1949, the same year the Oldsmobile 78 was replaced by the 88. The Ninety Eight would be discontinued after 1996, with its styling living on as the Eighty Eight derived Regency

The Electra Estate was redesigned, becoming the Roadmaster Estate for 1991. The Continental Mark V was assembled alongside the Lincoln Continental at Wixom Assembly (1957-2007), and were offered in several commemorative and designer editions; notable examples include the Diamond Jubilee Edition that was available in 1978 and the Bill Blass edition that was sold throughout the Mark V's three-year production run.
