Chirnside Park Shopping Centre The GPT Group assumed Chirnside Park Shopping Centre is a major regional shopping centre located in Chirnside Park, a suburb of Melbourne, Australia. eight-screen Reading Cinemas complex, which successfully extended the centre's trading hours and captured the evening entertainment market. Situated 32 kilometres east-north-east of the Melbourne central business district, the centre operates as a primary commercial and civic hub for the Yarra Valley region. The interior has an Art Deco lobby and escalators at the lower stories, as well as double-deck elevators linking the floors. Opening on 4 October 1966, Northland Shopping Centre was one of the first self-contained shopping centres in Melbourne. The shopping centre was built and owned by Myer. The original shopping centre consisted of three malls radiating north, east and west from a centre stage area. It housed 73 tenants and six professional suites. Some of the original retailers included Myer, Coles New World Supermarket, Buckley & Nunn, McEwans, Woolworths Variety Store and Coles Variety Store. A feature of the shopping centre was the Northland... 1d956ef6c8 The original site, located near the Don Valley Parkway on Don Mills Road in the former city of North York, is about 11 kilometres (6.8

mi) northeast of downtown Toronto. Built into the side of a ravine formed by a branch of the Don River, the museum consisted of a series of buildings constructed at different levels on a steep hill and connected by escalators. Large windows provided views of the surrounding forest and river. It was closed by the Government of Ontario in June 2024 after an engineering report identified a high risk of roof collapse. At the height of the housing boom, in mid-1973, Hanover announced plans to build a regional shopping complex at Vermont South alongside an additional 260 houses along Burwood Highway. Architect Ray Barnard-Brown planned the centre, which comprised a rectangular retail block with large anchor stores on either end, which were initially tenanted by branches of the Venture department store and Coles New World supermarket chains. 1d956ef6c8

The structure was originally named for the energy conglomerate Cities Service Company (later Citgo), its first tenant. Upon its completion, it was Lower Manhattan's tallest building and, until 1969, the world's third-tallest building. Designed by the architectural firm of Clinton & Russell, Holton & George in the Art Deco style, 70 Pine Street was constructed between 1930 and 1932 as an office building. S 1d956ef6c8
