Venu It is referred to as nadi and tunava in the Rigveda and other Vedic texts of Hinduism. It continues to be in use in the South Indian Carnatic music tradition. Even a PVC pipe can be used to construct a flute in a very simple way, simply using common The venu (Sanskrit: वनू; vēṇu/वनू; muraḷi) is one of the ancient transverse flutes of Indian classical music. It is an aerophone typically made from bamboo, that is a side blown wind instrument. In the south, it is also called by various other names such as pullanguḷaḷ (புல்லாங்குழல்) in Tamil (Tamil Nadu), oodakuḷaḷ (ஊதுகுழல்) or kurungu kuḷaḷ (குருங்கு குழல்) in Malayalam (Kerala) and koḷalu (ಕೊಳಲು) or muraḷi (ಮುರಳಿ) in Kannada (Karnataka). Submergence transitions for Parshall flumes range from 50% (1–3-inch sizes) to 80% (10–50-foot sizes), beyond which point level measurements must be taken at both The Parshall flume is an open channel flow-metering device that was developed to measure the flow of surface water and irrigation flow. Parshall of the U. The Parshall flume accelerates the flow by contracting both the parallel sidewalls and a drop in the floor at the flume throat. Differences between the Venturi and Parshall flume include reduction of the inlet converging angle, lengthening the throat section, reduction of the discharge divergence angle, and introducing a drop through the throat (and subsequent partial recovery in the discharge section). Under free-flow conditions, the depth of water at a specified location upstream of the flume throat can be converted to a rate of flow. Soil Conservation Service, the Parshall flume is a fixed hydraulic structure used in measuring volumetric flow rate in surface water, industrial discharges, municipal sewer lines, and influent/effluent flows in wastewater treatment plants. In 1982, The Washington Post called the unique approach to playgrounds a "burgeoning movement." Plastic welding constitutes a solvent weld. This technique is commonly used for connecting PVC and ABS pipe, as in household plumbing. Based on the mechanism of heat generation at the welding interface, welding methods for thermoplastics can be classified as external and internal heating methods, as shown in Fig 1. Welding of thermoplastics is accomplished in three sequential stages, namely surface preparation, application of heat and pressure, and cooling. During the IPS period, pipes were cast in halves and welded together, and pipe sizes referred to the inside diameters. The inside diameters under IPS were roughly the same as the more modern Ductile Iron Pipe Standard (DIPS) and Nominal Pipe Size (NPS) Standards, and some of the wall thicknesses were also retained with a different designator. In 1948, the DIPS came into effect, when greater control of a pipe's wall thickness was possible.

Friction loss is a significant engineering concern wherever fluids are made to flow, whether entirely enclosed in a pipe or duct, or with a surface open to the air. Production of a good quality weld does not only depend on the welding methods, but also weldability of base materials. Therefore, the evaluation of weldability is of higher importance than the welding operation (see rheological weldability) for plastics. The tin whistle in its modern form is from a wider family of fipple flutes which have been seen in many forms and cultures throughout the world. In Europe, such instruments have a long and distinguished history and take various forms, of which the most widely known are the recorder, tin whistle, Flabiol, Txistu and tabor pipe.

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
