Enterprise Rent-A-Car was established in St. Louis, Missouri, in 1957 by Jack C. Taylor. Originally known as "Executive Leasing Company," in 1969, Taylor renamed the company "Enterprise" after the aircraft carrier USS Enterprise, on which he served during World War II. Over time, as Saturn drained resources from GM's extensive brand network, the brand would be gradually re-integrated into the GM corporate hierarchy, losing its semi-independent nature and beginning to work on models that increasingly compromised the independence of the brand, first with mild use of shared GM products and platforms... The company is owned by its chairman, Ernest Garcia II, who bought the company... The company is led by CEO Daryl Kenningham and CFO Daniel McHenry. As of January 2025, CarMax operates 253 locations. The company began as a side business of Circuit City Corporation, Inc. CarMax Auto Finance operates from Kennesaw, Georgia. In 2021 CarMax, Inc. (edmunds) making it a wholly owned subsidiary

Effective December 1, 2025, CarMax appointed David McCreight as interim president and CEO. In addition, Tom Folliard, an executive with a 30 years of experience with the company... It abruptly ceased operations on September 24, 2008, as a result of the ongoing troubles in the subprime lending markets and slower car sales. At the closure, there were 13 dealerships in the Heard chain, plus one that had closed two weeks prior. Four days after the closure of its dealerships, Bill Heard Enterprises filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. Eventually, Asbury would expand out of the Atlanta area, adding St. Louis-based Plaza Motors while acquiring David McDavid's Texas dealerships, and later the Jacksonville, Florida.-based Coggin Automotive and Tampa, Florida-based Courtesy Automotive in 1998. A joint venture with the North Carolina-based Crown Automotive Group in 1999 saw Asbury eventually take full ownership of those dealerships, while moving...

Enterprise Rent-A-Car The company has historically concentrated on what it calls "home city" rentals, often people renting a car while their own was being repaired, but has expanded to airport-based rentals, especially after its parent
