The King's Mews occupied part of the site until the reign of George IV, who moved them to Buckingham Palace, allowing the area to be redeveloped by John Nash. Progress stalled after the death of Nash in 1835, and the square did not open until 1844. It is faced by buildings including the National Gallery, St Martin-in-the-Fields, Canada House and South Africa House. It was established in the early 19th century around the area known as Charing Cross. Construction went ahead beginning in 1840 but with the height reduced to 145 feet 3 inches (44. 27 m).
