The tip contact is indented with a groove. The sleeve contact is nearest the (conductive or insulated) handle. Contacts are insulated from each other by a band of non-conductive material. Between the tip and sleeve are zero to three ring contacts. They are easily identified by their short thick barrel and twin recoil buffers above the barrel. ca7e6312fa The sleeve is usually a common ground reference voltage or return current for signals in the tip and any rings.
