Mickey was created as a replacement for a prior character created by Disney, Oswald the Lucky Rabbit. The character was originally to be named "Mortimer Mouse", until Disney's wife, Lillian, suggested "Mickey". Mickey first appeared in two 1928 shorts *Plane Crazy* and *The Gallopin' Gaucho* (which were not picked up for distribution) before his public debut in *Steamboat Willie* (1928). The character went on to appear in over 130 films, mostly short films. His relatively few feature films include *Fantasia* (1940). Since 1930, Mickey has been featured extensively in comic strips (including the Mickey Mouse comic strip, which ran for 45 years) and comic books (such as *Mickey Mouse*).
