In another sense, a tile is a construction tile or similar object, such as rectangular counters used in playing games (see tile-based game). They are generally fixed in place in an array to cover roofs, floors, walls, edges, or other objects such as tabletops. meaning a roof tile composed of fired clay, otherwise known as nga. Alternatively, tile can sometimes refer to similar units made from lightweight materials such as perlite, wood, and mineral wool, typically used for wall and ceiling applications. The word is derived from the French word tuile, which is, in turn, from the Latin word tegula, meaning a roof tile composed of fired clay, otherwise known as nga

In the Jōmon period, from the 10,000 BC to 300 BC, people gathered into villages, where they lived in shallow pit-houses. These simple huts were between 10 and 30 square meters and had a hearth in the center. Early stoves were nothing more than a shallow pit (jishōro 竈), but they were soon surrounded by stones to catch the fire sparks. A bottomless clay vase soon replaced the stones as these became hot quickly and occupants had to be careful around a stove. This type of stove is called maiyōro (埋焼; lit. "buried vase stove"). As the stove became safer, it was moved from the center of house to the side... Raised floors are widely used in modern office buildings, and in specialized areas such as command centers, information technology data centers, and computer rooms, where there is a requirement to route mechanical services and cables, wiring, and electrical supply. Such flooring can be installed at varying heights from 2 inches (51 mm) to heights above 4 feet (1.2 m) to suit services that may be accommodated beneath. Additional structural support and lighting are often provided when a floor is raised enough for a person to

The level of detail included on a floor plan is directly tied to its intended use and phase of design. For instance, a plan produced in the schematic design phase may show only major divisions of space and approximate square footages while one produced for construction may indicate the construction types of various walls. Floor plans may indicate specific dimensions or square footages for particular rooms and/or walls. They may also include details of fixtures (sinks, water heaters, furnaces, etc), notes to specify finishes, construction methods, or symbols for electrical items.
