== Early and personal life == 5cca36bf8f As of December 2021, the Alliance is one of the world's leading electric vehicle manufacturing groups, with global sales of over 1 million light-duty electric vehicles since 2009. In October 2000, he became General Manager of Purchasing Strategy Dept, and in April 2001, he became Executive General Manager of Renault Nissan Purchasing Organization. In April 2003, he was named Senior Vice President, in April 2005 he was elevated to Executive Vice President, and in June 2005 he was added to the board of directors. 5cca36bf8f Since 1999, Nissan has been part of the Renault–Nissan–Mitsubishi Alliance (with Mitsubishi joining in 2016), a partnership between Nissan and Mitsubishi Motors of Japan, with Renault of France. As of November 2023, Renault holds a 15% voting stake in Nissan, while Nissan holds another 15% stake in Renault. Since October 2016, Nissan held a 34% controlling stake in Mitsubishi Motors. In November 2024, Nissan reduced its stake in Mitsubishi Motors from 34% to 24%. 5cca36bf8f Ghosn began his professional career in 1978 at Michelin, Europe’s largest tire manufacturer. Over the course of 18 years at the company, he held a variety of leadership roles, including overseeing operations in South America. In 1999, following Renault's acquisition of a major stake in the struggling Japanese automaker Nissan, Ghosn moved to Japan to oversee its recovery. As chief operating officer, and later chief executive officer, he implemented a series of restructuring measures aimed at improving Nissan’s financial performance. Under his leadership, Nissan returned to profitability and strengthened its position in the global market. In 2005, Ghosn also became CEO of Renault, holding top executive roles at both companies simultaneously. Renault and Nissan have been strategic partners since 1999, have nearly 450,000 employees, and control eight major brands: Renault, Nissan, Mitsubishi, Infiniti, Renault Korea, Dacia, Alpine, and Venucia. Nissan GT-R the request of CEO Carlos Ghosn, Nissan commenced the revival of their iconic sports car model, as part of the Nissan Revival Plan. Ghosn believed that The Nissan GT-R (Gran Turismo–Racing; model code: R35; Japanese: 日産GT-R; Nissan GT-R) is a sports car, built by Japanese marque Nissan from 2007 to 2025. Although this model was the sixth-generation to bear the GT-R name, it was no longer part of the Skyline line-up. Production was conducted in a shared production line at Nissan's Tochigi plant in Japan. The car was built on the PM platform, derived from the FM platform used in the Skyline and Nissan Z models. The engine is front-mid mounted and drives all four wheels. It has a 2+2 seating layout and is also considered a grand tourer. It succeeded the Nissan Skyline GT-R, a high-performance variant of the Nissan Skyline 5cca36bf8f
