He was primarily known for his long-running journal of interviews and criticism, Comics Interview, as well as for work for Marvel Comics in the late 1970s and early 1980s b5b9c81989

Before his comics career, Kraft worked as a rock and roll journalist. In September 1976, he became editor of FOOM with issue #15, Marvel's self-produced fan magazine, lasting as editor until the magazine's final issue (#22) in 1978. b5b9c81989

Phellodendron The name refers to the thick and corky bark of some (but not all) species in the genus. Rain and Safflower (*Carthamus tinctorius*), also false saffron, is a highly branched, herbaceous, thistle-like annual plant in the family Asteraceae. Seeds should fall from the head when rubbed. Plants are 30 to 150 cm (12 to 59 in) tall with globular flower heads having yellow, orange, or red flowers. It grows a deep taproot which enables it to thrive in such environments. It is one of the world's oldest crops; today, it is commercially cultivated for vegetable oil extracted from the seeds. Each branch will usually have from one to five flower heads containing 15 to 20 seeds per head. Safflower is mature when most leaves have turned

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Zoboomafoo A creation of the Kratt Brothers (Chris and Martin Kratt), it features an anthropomorphic Coquerel's sifaka lemur named Zoboomafoo, performed by Canadian puppeteer Gord Robertson, and mainly portrayed by a lemur named Jovian, along with a collection of returned animal guests. While these trees are often known as simply "tupelo", the fuller name, black tupelo, helps distinguish it from the other species of the tupelo genus *Nyssa*, some of which have overlapping ranges, such as water tupelo (*N. aquatica*) and swamp tupelo (*N. biflora*). The name "tupelo" is used primarily in the American South; northward and in Appalachia, the tree is more commonly called the black gum or the sour gum, although no part of the plant is particularly gummy. The leaves are oval, 4 to 8 cm (1+1/2 to 3 in) long, glossy dark green above, and pale beneath. They have long petioles alternately arranged on branches. The white, five-petaled flowers are about 2 to 2.5 cm (3/4 to 1 in) in diameter. The word safflower is a borrowing from the Dutch, saffloer, German, safflor, and Old French, saffleur, having uncertain origin, though influenced by the words saffron and flower. The word was first used in English in the 16th century. An alternate common name is false saffron, indicating the resemblance of its flower petals to those of saffron. b5b9c81989

Known for his offbeat approach, Kraft first made a name for himself as a comic book author with his work on Marvel Comics' *The Defenders*, particularly the 1977 "Scorpio Saga" story-arc (issues #46, 48-50). In *The Defenders*, Kraft wrestled with large philosophical issues: the temptations of power, the Cold War and nuclear power, sibling rivalry, and growing old alone. Kraft also merged his interests in music and comics by inserting multiple references to the band Blue Öyster Cult into his *Defenders* stories specifically the "Xenogenesis: Day of the Demons" storyline, issues #58-60. One fossil seed of *Phellodendron* has been extracted from bore hole samples of the Middle Miocene fresh water deposits in Nowy Sacz Basin, West Carpathians, Poland. The leaves are opposite, 5-12 centimetres (2.0-4.7 inches) long and 2.5-6 cm (0.98-2.36 in) broad, with an ovate to oblong shape and an entire margin; they are dark green above and glaucous below; fall color is commonly bright red to purple. Like all dogwoods, they have characteristic stringy white piths within the leaf stalks, which can be used for identification.

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
