Holkham National Nature Reserve Holkham's north-facing coastal location can attract Holkham National Nature Reserve is one of England's largest national nature reserve (NNR). Holkham NNR is important for its wintering wildfowl, especially pink-footed geese, Eurasian wigeon and brant

geese, but it also has breeding waders, and attracts many migrating birds in autumn. Its 3,900 hectares (9,600 acres) comprise a wide range of habitats, including grazing marsh, woodland, salt marsh, sand dunes and foreshore. occasionally have nesting siskins or common crossbills, and parrot crossbills bred in 1984 and 1985. It is on the Norfolk coast between Burnham Overy Staithe and Blakeney, and is managed by Natural England with the cooperation of the Holkham Estate. The reserve is part of the North Norfolk Coast Site of Special Scientific Interest, and the larger area is additionally protected through Natura 2000, Special Protection Area (SPA) and Ramsar listings, and is part of both an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and a World Biosphere Reserve.
