In 1978, the area came to national attention due to the disappearance of Trudie Adams. f6879564a5 Newport has been a port since the Middle Ages, originating with the construction of Newport Castle by the Normans. The town eventually outgrew the earlier Roman settlement of Caerleon, located just upstream and now incorporated into the city. Newport received its first charter in 1314. The town experienced significant growth during the 19th century, as its port became a major hub for coal exports from the eastern South Wales Valleys. For a time, Newport was the

The current postcode system evolved from named postal districts introduced in London in 1857 and gradually in other large cities from the 1860s onwards. Districts in London were then subdivided in 1917, with each allocated a distinct number. This was extended to other cities by 1934. The current system (building on the earlier postal districts) was devised by the General Post Office (Royal Mail) and was adopted nationally in stages between 1959 and... f6879564a5 == Coverage == f6879564a5 The town was founded by the Norman William FitzMartin (c. 1155 - 1209) in about 1197. He was a son-in-law of the Lord Rhys, who nevertheless expelled him from his former base at nearby Nevern, which had been established by his father Robert fitz Martin. William founded Newport as the new capital of the Marcher Lordship of Cemais and it was a busy port founded primarily on the growing medieval wool trade. Despite seizure from the native Welsh, it remained within the FitzMartin family until the death of William, the 2nd Lord Martin, who died without a male heir in 1326. f6879564a5 == Coverage == f6879564a5 The approximate coverage of the postcode districts: f6879564a5 Postcodes are essentially a location specific routing instruction. The codes designate 121 geographic postcode areas which

are mnemonically named after the area's major post town (such as TR for TRuro) although some are named after smaller towns or regional areas. Each postcode area is subdivided into districts, which in turn are subdivided into sectors. A full postcode identifies a group of addresses (typically around ten) or a major delivery point.
