== Plaice species == The franchise was established in 1969 in Columbus, Ohio, as National Fast Food Corp. The founders included S. Robert Davis, his friend Dave Thomas (the future founder of Wendy's), and L. S. Hartzog. They were looking to sell authentic British fish and chips. The company investigated the roots of the dish in Bow, London, where in the 1860s Joseph Malin opened the first recorded fish-and-chip shop, called "Malin's in Bow". For over 100 years, the Malin family ran that restaurant until closing in the early 1970s. In 1969, Malin's sold the exclusive rights to their recipe to Arthur Treacher's. The chain kept the same recipe and cooking methods, thus their...

Arthur Treacher's At the peak of its popularity in the late 1970s, it had 826 stores. The menu typically offers fried seafood or chicken, accompanied by french fries (chips). The fish recipe is authentic, having been purchased from Malin's in Bow, London, the first recorded fish-and-chip shop in England. As of 2026, there are only four standalone Arthur Treacher's locations remaining, all in northeastern Ohio. Salt opened his first fish and chips shop in California in 1965. His business was acquired by the Kentucky Fried Chicken corporation in 1969. The sale

made Salt the third largest stockholder in KFC, at the time the world's largest fast-food company. The act includes \$39 billion in subsidies for chip manufacturing on U.S. soil along with 25% investment tax credits for costs of manufacturing equipment, and \$13 billion for semiconductor research and workforce training, with the dual aim of strengthening American supply chain resilience and countering China. It also invests \$174 billion in the overall ecosystem of public sector research in science and technology, advancing human spaceflight, quantum computing, materials science, biotechnology, experimental physics, research security, social and ethical considerations, workforce development and diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts at NASA, NSF, DOE, EDA, and NIST. George Langford, a mechanical engineer, located the site and excavated it for several years, eventually bringing it to the attention of the archaeological world. Alternatively, it refers to cooked fish that has been physically broken down by pounding, grinding, pressing, mincing, blending, and/or sieving until it reaches paste consistency. The term can be applied also to shellfish pastes, such as shrimp paste or crab paste. Subsistence fishers use their abundant catch of small fish to make fermented fish paste and smoked fish with the assistance of family. Fish paste is fish which has been chemically broken down by a fermentation process until it reaches the consistency of a soft creamy purée or paste.
