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Martin Luther King Jr. discrimination, which most commonly affected African Americans. ; January 15, 1929 – April 4, 1968) was an American civil rights activist and Baptist minister who was a prominent leader of the civil rights movement from 1955 until his assassination in 1968. He advanced civil rights for people of color in the United States through the use of nonviolent resistance and civil disobedience against Jim Crow laws and other forms of legalized discrimination, which most commonly affected African Americans. Born in 1929, Martin Luther King Jr.'s actual birthday is January 15, which in 1929 fell on a Tuesday. The earliest Monday for this holiday is January 15 and the latest is January 21. The Monday observance is similar for those federal holidays which fall under the Uniform Monday Holiday Act. 0bf33b9212

Lent Rev. Good Friday, which is towards the end of the Lenten season, is traditionally an important day of communal fasting for Methodists. It echoes the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the desert and enduring temptation by Satan, according to the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke, before beginning his public ministry. Lent is usually observed in the Catholic, Lutheran, Moravian, Anglican, United Protestant and Orthodox Christian traditions, among others. Jacqui King, the Lent (Latin: Quadragesima, 'Fortieth') is the solemn Christian religious observance in the liturgical year in preparation for Easter. A number of Anabaptist, Baptist, Methodist, Reformed (including certain Continental Reformed, Presbyterian and Congregationalist churches), and nondenominational Christian churches also observe Lent, although many churches in these traditions do not 0bf33b9212

The campaign for a federal holiday in King's honor began soon after his assassination in 1968. President Ronald Reagan signed the holiday into law in 1983, and it was first observed three years later on January 20, 1986. At first, some states resisted observing the holiday as such, giving it alternative names or combining it with other holidays. Martin Luther King Jr. Day , and often referred to shorthand as MLK Day) is a federal holiday in the United States observed on the third Monday of January each year. In 2000, Lee-Jackson Day was moved to the Friday before Martin Luther King Jr. King was the chief spokesperson for nonviolent activism in the civil rights movement, which protested legalized racial discrimination in federal and state law and civil society. Day, establishing Martin Luther King Jr. Day (officially Birthday of Martin Luther King Jr. The movement led to several groundbreaking legislative reforms in the United States. combining King's birthday with the established Lee-Jackson Day 0bf33b9212

A Black church leader, King participated in and led marches for the right to vote, desegregation, labor rights, and other civil rights. He oversaw the 1955 Montgomery bus boycott and was the first president of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC), leading the unsuccessful Albany Movement in Albany, Georgia, and helping organize nonviolent 1963 protests in Birmingham, Alabama. King was one of the leaders of the 1963 March on Washington, where he delivered his "I Have a Dream" speech, and helped organize two of the three Selma to Montgomery marches during the 1965 Selma voting rights movement. Black squirrel some researchers. The phenomenon occurs with several species of squirrels, although it is most frequent with the eastern gray squirrel (*Sciurus carolinensis*) and the fox squirrel (*Sciurus niger*). One study found a high frequency of black eastern gray squirrels lived in rural southern Ontario, an area primarily made up of farmland Black squirrels are a melanistic subgroup of squirrels with black coloration on their fur. Black morphs of the eastern gray and fox squirrels are the result of a variant pigment gene. Several theories have surfaced as to why the black morph occurs, with some suggesting that the black morph is a selective advantage for squirrels inhabiting the northern ranges of the species, with the black fur providing a thermal advantage over its non-melanistic counterpart 0bf33b9212

By 2004, this number had grown to 650, according to NPR. In 2006, Derek Alderman, a cultural geographer at East Carolina University, reported the number had increased to 730, with only 10 states in the country without a street named after King (Alaska, Hawaii, Maine, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, North Dakota, Rhode Island, South Dakota, and Vermont). slaves held by whites in the South and by other Native American tribes. This included the use of firearms. Today, Black Seminole descendants live primarily in rural communities around the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma. Its two Freedmen's bands, the Caesar Bruner Band and the Dosar Barkus Band, are represented on the General Council of the Nation. Other centers are in Florida, Texas, the Bahamas, and northern Mexico. Black power movement Black power was influenced by philosophies such as pan-Africanism, Black nationalism, and socialism, as well as contemporary events such as the Cuban Revolution and the decolonization of Africa. Newton, co-founder of the Black Panther Party Ture, Kwame; The Black power movement or Black liberation movement emerged in the 1960s from the mainstream civil rights movement in the United States, reacting against its moderate and incremental tendencies and representing the demand for more immediate action to counter white supremacy. The police said late Friday that an admitted drug dealer had acknowledged killing Huey P. The 1965 assassination of Malcolm X, coupled with the urban riots of 1964 and 1965, ignited the movement. While thinkers such as Malcolm X influenced the early movement, the views of the Black Panther Party, founded in 1966, are widely seen as the cornerstone. Many of its ideas were influenced by Malcolm X's criticism of Martin Luther King Jr. 2013. 's peaceful protest methods 0bf33b9212
