2017 Barcelona attacks Abouyaaqoub fled the attack on foot, then killed another person in order to steal the victim's car and escape. He was later killed by police in Subirats, a town 31 kilometres (19 mi) west of Barcelona, on 21 August. He had been living in Ribes de Freser, Spain, a village near Ripoll. Said Aallaa, 19, was born in Naour, Morocco. war". He was shot and killed by police On the afternoon of 17 August 2017, 22-year-old Younes Abouyaaqoub drove a van into a crowd of pedestrians on La Rambla street in Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain, killing 13 people and injuring at least 130 others, one of whom died as a result of the injuries ten days later, on 27 August 72038bd988

Nine hours after the Barcelona attack, five more men, thought to be members of the same terrorist cell, drove into another group of pedestrians in nearby Cambrils, killing one woman and injuring six. All five of these attackers were shot and killed by police. 72038bd988 == Family and youth == 72038bd988 Alba began to study rights at a young age, beginning his studies at the University of Barcelona. He started his career as a political journalist at a young age. Affiliated with the Bloque Obrero y Campesino (Workers and Peasants' Bloc, BOC), he later worked for the Workers' Party of Marxist Unification (POUM) when the BOC combined with it. During the Spanish Civil War, he was the director of La Batalla, the organ of expression for the POUM. After the capture of the Basque region by Francoist forces in May 1937 he was arrested and jailed for six years in Valencia. After leaving prison, he went into exile in France, where he worked alongside Albert Camus, and in 1947 moved to Mexico, where he published various works. In Mexico he began a prolific literary production, in Spanish, French, Catalan and English, and became director of the Social Training center. Ramón Massó Tarruella In historiography he is moderately recognized for his role in politics of mid-Francoism. family. His grandfather Ramón Massó Marcer (died 1936) originated from Sant Pere de Ribes. He was leading the group of young Carlist activists who challenged the Traditionalists and eventually ensured domination of the progressist current. He gained nationwide recognition in the 1970s and 1980s, when as academic, theorist and brand communications specialist he published numerous books and co-ran a media agency. In 1885, during rapid expansion of the Catalan textile industry, Ramón Massó Tarruella (1928–2017) was a Spanish media and communications expert, known also for his role in Carlism of the 1960s. However, his bid to promote Prince Carlos Hugo as a future monarch and as an alternative to prince Juan Carlos failed 72038bd988

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
