Heavily influenced by the

popular Apples to Apples card game, it was initially named Cardenfreude (a pun on the German concept Schadenfreude) and involved a group of players writing out the most abstract and, often, humorous response to the topic question. The name was later changed to Cards Against Humanity, with the answers pre-written on the white cards known today. Co-creator Ben Hantoot cited experiences with various games such as Magic: The Gathering, Balderdash, and charades as inspiration, also noting that Mad Libs was "the most direct influence" for the game. 326b39db7a Board game cafés seem to have begun in South Korea; in 2004, Seoul had 130 board game cafés.
