

How Much Is A Radiator Flush

In 1937 the idea was raised of attempting a new world landplane speed record with a modified Spitfire. At the time the record of 352 mph (566 km/h) was held by Howard Hughes flying a Hughes H-1 racing aircraft. Although only the prototype K5054 had yet flown, a production Spitfire was expected to be capable of 362 mph (583 km/h) at a height of 16,800 ft (5,100 m). However the speed record had to be flown at an altitude no greater than 245 ft (75 m). The Spitfire was much slower at such a low level; the prototype was only capable of 290 mph (470 km/h) at this height. Consequently, a record-breaking machine would have to be extensively modified. Air lock problems often occur when one is trying to recommission a system after it has been deliberately (for servicing) or accidentally emptied. Take, for example, a central heating system using a circulating pump to pump water through radiators.

When filling such a system, air is trapped in the radiators. This air has to be vented using screw valves built into the radiators. Depending on the pipe layout - if there are any upside down 'U's in the circuit - it will be necessary to vent the highest point(s). Otherwise, air lock may cause waterfall flow where the loss of hydraulic head is equal to the height of airlock; If the hydraulic grade line drops below the output of the pipe, the flow through that part of the circuit would stop completely. The heating radiator was invented by Franz San Galli in 1855, a Kingdom of Prussia-born Russian businessman living in St. Petersburg.
