List of Neighbours characters introduced in 1999 The following is a list of characters that first appeared in the serial in 1999, by order of first appearance. It was first broadcast on 18 March 1985. Charlie Thorpe debuted in October, along with the five-strong Scully family consisting of parents Joe and Lyn, and their daughters Stephanie, Felicity and Michelle. The 15th season of Neighbours began airing from 18 January 1999. All characters were introduced by the show's then executive producer Stanley Walsh. Prime7 Similarly, the Mildura licence area remained separate from the remainder of Victoria, albeit with Prime7, formerly Prime Television and other names, was an Australian television network. Prime Television launched on 17 March 1962 as CBN-8 in Orange, and later expanded to cover regional New South Wales, Victoria and the Australian Capital Territory. It was initially an independent affiliate owned by Prime Media Group before the network, and its sister GWN7, were acquired by Seven West Media on 31 December 2021. In November 2011, TransACT was acquired by iiNet Limited, which in 2015 itself became a subsidiary of TPG. It continues to trade as TransACT. Subscription television in Australia Regulation of the sector is assured by the Australian Communications and Media Authority. fibre coaxial (HFC) cable networks in three Victorian regional cities of Mildura, Ballarat and Geelong was acquired by TransACT at the end of 2007. Notable actors in the sector include Foxtel, Netflix, Stan, Amazon Prime Video and Disney+. In November Subscription television in Australia is provided using technologies such as cable television, satellite television and internet television by a number of companies unified in their provision of a subscription television service c85bb7f18d

In 2012, prior to market entry of some major digital streaming services to Australia, only about 28% of Australian homes had a pay TV subscription, which was one of the lowest subscriber rates in the developed world. By 2019, the situation had evolved so that almost 14 million Australians had access to a paid television or video on demand service. c85bb7f18d

TransACT (HFC) cable networks and customers in three Victorian regional cities of Mildura, Ballarat and Geelong, and rebranded it as TransACT in June 2011. The first TransACT was the trading name of TransACT Capital Communications, an Australian telecommunications company based in Canberra which provided wholesale broadband internet access, fixed telephony, cable television services, and mobile phone services in Canberra and a subset of these services in

Queanbeyan, throughout South-east New South Wales and in Victoria

On 18 December 2015, a test pattern began broadcasting on channel 76, reading "New Channel Coming Soon". Seven acknowledged the broadcast, and director of programming, Angus Ross, formally announced on 1 February 2016 that Seven was launching a new channel, and more details would be released soon. During the ad-break of miniseries Molly on 7 February 2016, Seven announced that channel 76 would be named 7flix, and would be launched on 28 February 2016. The "New Channel" test pattern then was replaced with a continuous promo loop for 7flix.

By 2001, the company had run 900 kilometres worth of hybrid fibre coaxial cable past 38,000 homes in Mildura and Ballarat, with 1500 customers, and with planned rollouts in Bendigo, Geelong, Shepparton and Albury-Wodonga.

Prime7 along with GWN7's national broadcast facilities were based in Canberra, with playout facilities (since 2021) shared with hybrid-funded broadcaster SBS Television at a facility operated by Australian telecommunications provider Telstra. Seven West Media head office/administration is located in Pyrmont, Sydney.

The company delivered cable television, broadband internet and telephony services via these cable networks. It also offered internet services via Telstra's copper network and wireless equipment. 7flix began broadcasting at 6am on 28 February 2016 in MPEG-4. The channel airs movies in its prime time slots with television series and other entertainment at other times. 7flix was added to Seven's live-streaming service, PLUS7 Live, upon its launch.

The Real Housewives of Melbourne was first announced by Matchbox Pictures as The Real Housewives of Australia and was set to air in 2013. On 28 July 2013 it was announced that the series had been renamed to The Real Housewives of Melbourne, along with the full cast. The six women featured on the first season were handpicked by the producers, from over one-hundred women during an eight-month process. Filming for the season began in July 2013. The official cast photo and premiere date for the series was announced on 21 January 2014.

TVSN began broadcasting on 4 December 1995 from the North Ryde studios owned

by Global Television (originally owned by Channel 10 Sydney) as The Value Channel. Warehousing was located off-site, as were the management and buying team. In May 1996, the channel was acquired by investors in Hong Kong and was rebranded as TVSN in June. It was soon listed on the Australian Securities Exchange in 1999 after sustaining some growth. Later in 2001, the channel moved to a purpose-built facility close by in Lane Cove, which also included onsite warehousing and management offices, being the first time all aspects of the operation were contained within the one location. A number of subscription TV channels have solely or were first seen in Australia on their network. It... Josh Anderson (Neighbours) Josh is characterised as academically bright and good at chemistry. The latter storyline challenged Angerson who felt nervous portraying a stripper. are left homeless and jobless with the prospect of having to return to Mildura, which Josh does not really want as he has made friends and is settled Josh Anderson is a fictional character from the Australian soap opera Neighbours, played by Jeremy Angerson. He arrives in Erinsborough following his father's relocation to the area. Producers hired Angerson because they were increasing the size of the male cast. He first appeared on-screen in the episode airing on 5 February 1990. Angerson has described Josh as "naïve and a bit unpredictable" and "honest". He later described filming Josh's stripping scenes as "pretty horrendous" and an "horrific experience". Other stories

included a relationship with Phoebe Bright (Simone Robertson), the issue of temporary blindness and Josh becoming a stripper. During his tenure Josh helped to form the show's group of teenage characters consisting of himself, Todd Landers (Kristian Schmid), Melissa Jarrett (Jade Amenta) and Cody Willis (Amelia Frid) c85bb7f18d

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
