== Laundry topics == While 85% of households in the United States have laundry machines, self-service laundries are used by people who do not have their own machines. Even those who have their own machines sometimes use them for large bedding and other items that cannot fit into residential washers and dryers. Some multifamily dwellings have self-service laundry facilities available for use by tenants.

A similar, more dilute preparation meant to be applied to dry fabric is known as a wrinkle releaser

Washing machines exert significant mechanical stress on textiles, particularly natural fibers such as cotton and wool. The fibers at the fabric's surface become squashed and frayed, and this condition hardens into... Dryer balls are typically manufactured out of felted wool (the original material used for manufacture), rubber, or plastic. Wool variants are typically smooth, while rubber or plastic variants typically include spiked protrusions and may be shaped differently than a sphere. Rubber and plastic balls are more durable than woolen ones, which need periodic replacement depending on frequency of use.

"Utility" refers to an item

which is designed for usefulness or practical use, so in turn most of the items kept in this room have functional attributes, i.e. "form follows function". Laundry work has traditionally been highly gendered, with the responsibility in most cultures falling to women (formerly known as laundresses or washerwomen). The Industrial Revolution gradually led to mechanized solutions to laundry work, notably the washing machine and later the tumble dryer. Tumble dryers Aside from the early wringer/washer machine of the mid-19th century, washing and drying machines were not combined until the latter half of the 20th century. The first completely automatic clothes washer was developed by Bendix Home Appliances in 1937; the same company also invented the first washer-dryer combination unit in 1953. Using such a machine may cause clothes to shrink or become less soft (by loss of short soft fibers). A simpler non-rotating machine called a "drying cabinet" may be used for delicate fabrics and other items not suitable for a tumble dryer.
