In technical terms, an allergen is an antigen that is capable of stimulating a type-I hypersensitivity reaction in atopic individuals through immunoglobulin E (IgE) responses. == Background and history == Investigations by Boeing, air quality organizations such as the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE), and various academic researchers into the efficacy of the air purifiers sold by Dyson raised concerns about both their effectiveness and the potential negative health effects that could occur from the high levels of negative ions produced by the devices. In response, the company filed lawsuits against a member of ASHRAE and the academic publisher Elsevier. A HEPA filter must satisfy certain levels of efficiency. Common standards require that a HEPA air filter must remove—from the air that passes through—at least 99.95% (ISO, European Standard) or 99.97% (ASME, U.S. DOE) of particles whose diameter is equal to 0.3 μm , with the filtration efficiency increasing for particle diameters both less than and greater than 0.3 μm . HEPA filters capture pollen, dirt, dust, moisture, bacteria (0.2–2.0 μm), viruses (0.02–0.3 μm), and submicron liquid aerosol (0.02–0.5 μm). Some microorganisms, for example, *Aspergillus niger*, *Penicillium citrinum*, *Staphylococcus epidermidis*, and *Bacillus subtilis* are captured by HEPA filters with photocatalytic oxidation (PCO). A HEPA filter is also able to capture some viruses and bacteria which are $\leq 0.3 \mu\text{m}$. A HEPA filter is also able to capture floor dust which contains bacteroidia, clostridia, and bacilli. == History == Examples == Commercial grade air purifiers are manufactured as either small stand-alone units or larger units that can be affixed to an air handler unit (AHU) or to an HVAC unit found in the medical, industrial, and commercial industries. Air purifiers may also be used in industry to remove impurities from air before processing. Pressure swing adsorbents or other adsorption techniques are typically used for this.

Among the eight known cat allergens, the most prominent allergen is secretoglobulin Fel d 1, which is produced in the anal glands, salivary glands, and, mainly, in sebaceous glands of cats, and is ubiquitous in the United States, even in households without cats.

Sensitivities vary widely from one person (or from one animal) to another. A very broad range of substances can be allergens to sensitive individuals. Severe dust mite infestation in the home has been linked to atopic dermatitis, and epidermal barrier damage has been documented. Homemade, do-it-yourself air cleaners using air filters are low-cost, high performance alternatives to commercial, stand-alone portable air cleaners. A 2022 study found the clean air delivery rate on the five-filter design was between 600 and 850 cubic feet (17–24 m³) per minute (depending on fan speed), while costing roughly a tenth of commercial air filters. Engineers Richard Corsi and Jim Rosenthal created the five-filter design during the COVID-19 pandemic, with the goal of reducing the risk of infection by reducing the levels of airborne viral particles in indoor settings.
