Paddington is always polite—addressing people as "Mr", "Mrs", and "Miss", but rarely by first names—and kindhearted, though he inflicts hard stares on those who incur his disapproval. He has an endless capacity for innocently getting into trouble, but is known to "try so hard to get things right". After being discovered in London Paddington station by the Brown family, he was adopted and named "Paddington Brown", as his original name in bear language was too hard for the (human) Browns to pronounce. 87b36a989e Teddy (voiced by Bob Hoskins) – a bad-tempered scruffy bear. Sometimes he moans about everything and whenever he passes or sees green vegetables, he exclaims in disgust: "Sprouts! I hate sprouts!". In the episode called "Baby", he

== Characters ==

87b36a989e The attraction is a stage show featuring audio-animatronic figures. Most of the characters are bears who perform country music. Characters rise up to the stage on platforms, descend from the ceiling, and appear from behind curtains. The theater includes three audio-animatronic animal heads mounted on the walls who interact with characters on stage. 87b36a989e Leuralla was built for the independently wealthy yachtsman and big-game fisherman Harry Andreas (1879 - 1955), his wife Alice and their young family. Due to popularity, The Country Bear Jamboree was given a two "spin-off" shows.
