The community is represented by the Lewis Estates Community League, established in 1993. In 2013, Rapid Metro was introduced in Cyber City, connecting it to the Delhi Metro. The operational stations are within Cyber City. The National Highway 48 (NH-48) runs through Cyber City, and a project to construct a 16-lane expressway is also in progress. A flyover between Cyber City and MG Road was opened in 2015 to reduce traffic congestion. The Indira Gandhi International Airport is located close to the city. Delhi Metro Phase 4 includes an extension of the Yellow Line beyond HUDA City Centre (Millennium City Centre), improving direct access from central Delhi, including Rajiv Chowk. The remaining one in four (25%) residences were apartment style condominiums in low-rise buildings with fewer than five stories. Substantially all (97%) were owner occupied, with only 3% being rented. Cyber Hub is a large shopping and dining area with several restaurants and shops, catering primarily to the working in DLF Cyber City.
