Halal It encompasses broader ethical considerations, including fairness, social justice, and the treatment of animals. Sikhism forbids eating meat from animals that Halal (; Arabic: حلال ḥalāl [ħaˈlaːl]) is an Arabic word that translates to 'permissible' in English. The concept of halal is central to Islamic practices and is derived from the Quran and the Sunnah (the teachings and practices of the Prophet Muhammad). Although the term halal is often associated with Islamic dietary laws, particularly meat that is slaughtered according to Islamic guidelines, it also governs ethical practices in business, finance (such as the prohibition of usury (riba)), and daily living. result, kosher meat is permitted by some Muslim communities, and is sometimes substituted for halal meat cc87353980
