The quantities at which these trades are placed are referred to as "bid size" and "ask size". For instance, if a trader submits a limit order to buy 1,000 shares of MSFT at \$28.00, this order will appear in a market maker for MSFT's book with a bid of \$28.00 and a bid size of 1000. The difference between the bid and ask price is known as the bid-ask spread. After the late 1990s buy-to-let grew strongly. In some sectors, economists have characterized dynamic pricing as having welfare improvements over uniform pricing and contributing to more optimal allocation of limited resources. Its usage often stirs public controversy, as people frequently think of it as price gouging. 338855d312 The practice is distinct from return policies: price adjustments allow a refund of the difference even if the item has already been used, whereas returns generally require the item to be in unused or resaleable condition.
