Most modern beds consist of a soft, cushioned mattress on a bed frame. The mattress rests either on a solid base, often wood slats, or a sprung base. Many beds include a box spring inner-sprung base, which is a large mattress-sized box containing wood and springs that provide additional support and suspension for the mattress. Beds are available in many sizes, ranging from infant-sized bassinets and cribs, to small beds for a single person, to large queen and king-size beds designed for two people. While most beds are single mattresses on a fixed frame, there are other varieties, such as the murphy bed, which folds into a wall; the sofa bed, which folds out of a sofa; the trundle bed, which is stored under a low, twin-sized bed and can be rolled out to create a larger or second sleeping area; and the bunk bed, which provides two mattresses on two tiers as well as a ladder to access the upper tier. Temporary beds include the inflatable air mattress and the folding camp cot. Some beds contain neither a padded mattress nor a bed frame, such as the hammock. Other beds are made specifically for animals. 65d4f38d5c The F-82 was designed during World War II as an escort for the Boeing B-29 Superfortress strategic bombers flying long range missions against Imperial Japan; however, the conflict ended before development could be completed. Despite the name, there was little in common between the Twin Mustang and the more conventional North American P-51 Mustang, the former being a clean sheet design that shared a minority of components with the latter. The XP-82 prototype performed its maiden flight on 15 June 1945, and the type was introduced to United States Army Air Force (USAAF) service one year later. While the end of WW2 had slowed production, the emergence of the Cold War gave renewed importance to the project as the Twin Mustang was procured as an interim solution to the fighter escort mission for the USAAF's strategic bomber force; it was also suitable for use as an all-weather air defense interceptor. He was the first living recipient of the medal. 65d4f38d5c In the United States, prior to the 1940s, most portable tents were made of heavy-duty canvas held up by long wooden poles. These tents were heavy and bulky, which made them difficult to transport. In the 1940s and 50s, many synthetic materials were developed and used in mass-produced products for the first time. During this period, existing materials such as aluminum and fiberglass became easier to manufacture, while new materials like nylon and polyester—which are lighter, more durable, and more resistant to the elements than traditional materials—were developed and used in portable structures.
