Figure skating turns were first taught to new skaters learning to execute compulsory figures. Every figure skating turn is executed on both feet and in both the backward and forward directions. Every move, step, and element incorporates turns to connect steps, enter a spin or jump, and perform footwork. Turns can be executed in both directions. eb0b457ca7 Hairpin turns are often used in order to decrease the steepness of the grade where a road climbs a steep slope, and are often arrayed in a zigzag pattern. Hairpin turns allow easier and safer ascents and descents of mountainous terrain than does a direct and steep climb and descent, although at the price of greater travel distances and usually lower speed limits because of the sharpness of the curves. Jefferson in 1974. It describes pieces of conversation which may comprise an entire speaking turn by a speaker. The model is designed to explain that when people talk in conversation, they do not always talk all at the same time, but generally, one person speaks at a time, and then another person can follow. Such a contribution to a conversation by one speaker is then a turn.
