Informal measurements such as a "pinch", a "drop", or a "hint" (soupçon) continue to be used from time to time. According to a survey of industry commentators, a flat white is a shorter drink with a thin layer of microfoam (hence the 'flat' in flat white), as opposed to the thick layer of foam on the top of a cappuccino.
