Chinese dining customs emphasize communal eating, with dishes shared among all diners rather than ordered individually. Round tables are preferred for larger groups

to facilitate sharing, often featuring Lazy Susan turntables at the center. A traditional place setting includes a small teacup, a plate with a rice bowl, chopsticks placed to the right of the plate, and a soup spoon. Seating arrangements follow a strict hierarchy based on age and social status, with the seat of honor typically facing east or the entrance, reserved for the host or eldest person. Multiple main dishes are served together rather than in individual courses, usually totaling one dish per person at the table, though celebratory events may feature ten or more dishes. **Importance** Picnic tables are made in various shapes, from circles to hexagons, and in a wide range of sizes. Traditional picnic tables often pose challenges for accessibility, especially for wheelchair users, but various designs for accessible picnic tables also exist.

In Japan, it is customary to say itadakimasu (いただきます); literally "I humbly receive" before starting to eat a meal. Similar to the French phrase bon app  tit or the act of saying grace, itadakimasu serves as an expression of gratitude for all who played a role in providing the food, including farmers, as well as the living organisms that gave their life to become part of the meal. Saying itadakimasu before a meal has been described as both a secular and a religious practice.

Tableware The quality, nature, variety and number of objects varies according to culture, religion, number of diners, cuisine and occasion. Tableware items are the dishware and utensils used for setting a table, serving food, and dining. Special occasions are usually reflected in higher quality tableware. For example, Middle Eastern, Indian or Polynesian food culture and cuisine sometimes limits tableware to serving dishes, using bread or leaves as individual plates, and not infrequently without use of cutlery. Originally office space, the State Dining Room received its name during the presidency of James Monroe, at which time it was first extensively furnished. The room was refurbished during several administrations in the early to mid 1800s, and gasified in 1853. Doors were cut through the west wall in 1877. The State Dining Room underwent a major expansion and renovation in 1902, transforming it from a Victorian dining room into a "baronial" dining hall of the early 19th century—complete with stuffed animal heads on the walls and dark oak panelling.
