== History == Underlay or underlayment generally refers to a layer of cushioning made of materials such as sponge rubber, foam, felt, crumb rubber, or recycled plastic; this material is laid beneath carpeting to provide comfort underfoot, to reduce wear on the carpet, and to provide insulation against sound, moisture, and heat. In general, it is a layer which is underneath another layer, so underlay is thus also used to describe many different surface-covering products. Floating floors as used in sound studios can be either just larger versions of the domestic... Materials almost always classified as flooring include carpet, laminate, tile, and vinyl. A domestic floating floor might be constructed over a subfloor or even over an existing floor. It can consist of a glass fibre, felt or cork layer for sound insulation with neoprene pads holding up a laminate floor. There is a gap between the floating floor and the walls to decouple them and allow for expansion; this gap is covered with skirting boards or mouldings.

Lamination A laminate is a layered object or material assembled using heat, pressure, welding, or adhesives. Paper laminations are also used in packaging. fiberboards giving a good-looking and resistant surface for use as furniture, decoration panels and flooring.

Lamination is the technique/process of manufacturing a material in multiple layers, so that the composite material achieves improved strength, stability, sound insulation, appearance, or other properties from the use of the differing materials, such as plastic. Various coating machines, machine presses and calendering equipment are used bf505e8371

There are different lamination processes, depending primarily on the type or types of materials to be laminated. The materials used in laminates can be identical or different, depending on the object to be laminated, the process and the desired properties.

Flooring Flooring is the general term for a permanent covering of a floor, or for the work of installing such a floor covering. Floor covering is a term to generically describe any finish material applied over a floor structure to provide a walking surface. flooring include carpet, laminate, tile, and vinyl. Both terms are used interchangeably but floor covering refers more to loose-laid materials.

The floor under the flooring is called the subfloor, which provides the support for the flooring bf505e8371

In vinyl flooring or "linoleum", the underlay is the thin layer of plywood that is fastened over the structural subfloor to create a uniform, smooth platform for the sheet vinyl. For laminated wood flooring, the underlay provides a "vapor barrier" to prevent moisture from coming through the floor of the home and then migrating into the flooring; the underlayment may also have noise-dampening properties. bf505e8371

Performance surface Performance surfaces are normally designed as a sprung floor with additional material or layers on top, to create a complete dance floor or sports floor. suspended flooring or the sprung floor. This includes theatrical, athletic, and recreational forms of performance. Roll-up vinyl sheeting A performance surface is a type of flooring with attributes suitable for dance or sport. Dance performance surfaces are denoted by using a layer of Marley, a popular type of vinyl, on top of a sprung floor. The word performance in this context will refer to any means of displaying physical movement. For professional dance, vinyl sheeting is commonly placed on top and may be removable or replaceable. Theatres often have a number of roll-out floors with different characteristics to satisfy the requirements of different forms of dance. However, these different disciplines all require specialized floors to accommodate their specific physicality. In addition, athletic flooring has been found to require different and new technological mechanisms to enhance performance. Flooring for spaces like clubs or ballrooms also serves a different purpose and therefore utilizes different properties

Floating floor The term floating floor refers to the installation method, but is often used synonymously with laminate flooring. It is applied now to other coverings such as floating tile systems and vinyl flooring in a domestic context. A floating floor is a floor that does not need to be nailed or glued to the subfloor.
