It is typically used for covering large surfaces with an even coating of liquid. Spray guns can either be automated or hand-held and have interchangeable heads to allow

Powder coating Unlike conventional liquid paint, which is delivered via an evaporating solvent, powder coating is typically applied electrostatically and then cured under heat or with ultraviolet light. It is usually used to create a thick, tough finish that is more durable than conventional paint. Powder coating is mainly used for coating of metal objects, particularly those subject to rough use. Advancements in powder coating technology like UV-curable powder coatings allow for other materials such as plastics, composites, carbon fiber, medium-density fibreboard (MDF), and solid wood to be powder coated, as little heat or oven dwell time is required to process them. At the professional scale, the capital expense and time required for a powder coat gun Powder coating is a type of coating that is applied as a free-flowing, dry powder. Rotary atomizers can provide highest transfer efficiency of any paint applicator at approximately 95%. This means that the applicator puts an electric charge on each droplet of paint to attract it to the part being sprayed. Rotary atomizers are able to get higher transfer efficiency compared to other spray guns because of its unique spinning bell cup. The bell cup inside the applicator, spins the material at 20,000 to 60,000 revolutions per minute. Due to the high rotation speed, the paint is subjected to high centrifugal force. This forces the paint to flow along the edge of the spinning cup.
