Concordia German Evangelical Church and Rectory C. The parsonage was built in 1885. It continues to offer German language services and events today, as well as in English. Concordia Church has been located in Foggy Bottom on the corner of G and 20th streets since 1833. It is a member congregation of the United Church of Christ and the United Methodist Church. The church building, located directly west of the parsonage, was dedicated May 15, 1892, and remains mostly in its original state. It is significant both historically and architecturally. The two buildings stand on a site that was in continuous ownership of the German congregation that built them since the late eighteenth century when the area was known as Funkstown or Hamburg, an early settlement that predated the founding of Washington. An order of Masons was organized in Sparta in 1854. Meetings were held in homes until 1891, when a Masonic Temple was constructed at the corner of Main and Water Streets. By 1919 the various lodges that shared the building had outgrown it, so they bought land and constructed the new building, which is the subject of this article. 1d708c2762 == Property == 1d708c2762 The Kuhns farm includes the farmhouse, a bank barn, a windmill, a "grossdaadi haus," (grandfather house), an outhouse, a food drying house, a bake oven,

a smokehouse, a root cellar, a hoghouse, and a garden plot. Associated with the farmstead is a cider mill, which was operated by the Kuhns family. The mill building was moved onto the property by the family around 1900. The mill is not a part of the historic area because it was moved onto the property. 1d708c2762

The windmill and root cellar are structures, which were supportive of human activities. The windmill was used to generate power; the root cellar was related to food storage. 1d708c2762 Construction began in 1909, as reported in the Pierre Weekly Free Press in April of that year, which described it as destined to be "one of the finest residences in Pierre when completed." The house was designed by architect E. J. Donohue of the Gilfillan Block, St. Paul, Minnesota, in the Colonial Revival style. Donohue's design exhibits Georgian and Adamesque influences and features Ionic columns on the porch, two-story Ionic pilasters at the front corners, Palladian windows, and a dentillated cornice. The house's first owner, Colonel E. P. Farr, was a veteran and banker; his wife, Mary Noyes Farr, was one of the first female doctors in Pierre. Peter Norbeck later lived in the house during his term as Governor of South Dakota, and Governor Carl Gunderson also lived in the house for a short time. The house is a single-family residence that has rooms available on AirBnB. 1d708c2762 The word "pantry" derives from the same source as the Old French term paneterie; that is from pain, the French form of the Latin panis, "bread". 1d708c2762 The palace originally belonged to the prince of the Hachijō-no-miya (□□□) family. The Imperial Household Agency currently administers the site. Although the Imperial Villa itself is not open to visitors, public tours of the gardens are available by appointment. 1d708c2762

Hutmacher Farm Shelves on the wall held jars of processed food. The farm was owned by the Hutmacher family, Black Sea German immigrants from South Russia (now southern Ukraine). The farm exemplifies the architecture of ethnic Germans. still present in the rafters and the stove still stands in one corner of the building. The chicken coop was The Hutmacher Farm near Manning, North Dakota, United States, is a farm that was first developed in 1911

The Hutmacher home consists of five rooms: two bedrooms, a living room, kitchen, and foyer/pantry. The house was built in stages between 1928 and 1962. 1d708c2762

The granary is directly north of the house. Its design and structure are the same as the house, with the doorway facing south. As its name implies, the granary stored harvested grain. Cured meats were buried in the... 1d708c2762 The farm site consists of five buildings: the farmhouse, garage/summer kitchen, granary, chicken coop and barn. To the east are the remains of Valentine Hutmacher's original homestead and the spring well where the families obtained water. == History == 1d708c2762 The house was added to the National Register of Historic Places on December 4, 1980. 1d708c2762 == History == 1d708c2762 In 2010 Acadia Plantation was demolished and a plaque was placed on Hwy 1 next to Nicholls State University in memory of the plantation. Construction crews worked from the inside out as they dismantled portions of the historic plantation home. The land and home was purchased by Jake Giardina and partner Ron Adams in 2003 from the Plater family as part of a 3,000-acre transaction. The home's future had been a topic of local debate since that time, although there have been no organized attempts to save it. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The

3,400-acre plot of land is now a subdivision which includes a mix of stores, restaurants and homes to the people of Thibodaux. The 132-acres of Acadia Plantation is now developed into residential homes and businesses. The style and arrangement is similar to those found in the New Orleans French Quarter... 1d708c2762

Stahly-Nissley-Kuhns Farm Off the kitchen is a pantry. This tiny bedroom has an east window with a view of the barn. On the west The Stahly-Nissley-Kuhns Farm is a historic farm located at Nappanee, Indiana. Nappanee was established in 1874. The Farm is part of Amish Acres, which includes the old farmstead and additional structures brought in to show Amish life. above. Off the living room is the master bedroom 1d708c2762

The name Steepletop comes from a pink, conical wildflower that grows there known as Steeplebush. 1d708c2762 Also known as the Frank Hutmacher Farm or the Valentine Hutmacher Farm, it was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1979. The listing included six contributing buildings, three contributing sites and a contributing structure. 1d708c2762 Sparta's new Masonic Temple was completed in 1923, with construction delayed because of the steel shortage due to WWI. The building was designed by Parkinson & Dockendorff of La Crosse, combining the proportions of Classical Revival style with the low-pitched hip roof and wide eaves of Prairie Style. The framework is reinforced concrete and steel, clad in cream brick. Two-story pilasters are formed from that brick. The roof is covered in red tile. The Sparta Herald gave a nice description of the inside when it opened in 1923: 1d708c2762

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
